1. **REOPENING OF SCHOOL:**

Schools reopen on 12 January 2022. Please take note that Fleur Primary School will continue with the **alternative day/group timetable**, as was used in 2021. Please take careful note of the following start dates for each grade.

2. **NEW LEARNERS:**

All new learners will receive an orientation pack via email. Parents/Learners are to familiarise themselves with the procedures and rules of Fleur Primary School.

3. **SCHOOL TIMES:**

Please take note of the school times for each Grade. Ensure that learners arrive at school timeously from 07:00 so as to allow for the screening process to take place.

Please do not drop learners off at school earlier than 07:00 as teachers will only be on duty from 07:00.

7. **STATIONERY:**

8. **EXERCISE BOOK PACKS AND TEXTBOOKS:**

These will be issued to your child/ward in the first week of school opening.

9. **ENTRANCES AND EXITS:**

- Grade 7 learners enter and exit at the gate on Hans Strijdom Avenue (Grade 7 Gate).
- Grade 6 learners will enter and exit at the Park gates on Van Riebeeck Avenue (Grade R Gate).
- Grade 5 learners will enter and exit at the pedestrian gate (teachers' parking area) on Molteno Avenue (Grade 2 Gate).
- Grade 4 learners will enter and exit at the old waiting area (in front of the Butterfly class) on Hans Strijdom Avenue (Grade 1 Gate).
- Grade R and Grade 3 learners will enter and exit at the Park Gate (Grade R side) on Van Riebeeck Avenue.
- Grade 1 learners will enter and exit at the old waiting area (in front of the Butterfly class) on Hans Strijdom Avenue.
- Grade 2 learners will enter and exit at the Pedestrian gate (teachers parking area) on Molteno Avenue.

10. **UNIFORM:**

School summer uniform is to be worn this term. Ensure that your child/ward wears his/her PE uniform only on the days that he/she has PE.

Please ensure uniforms are washed each day so that learners are using a clean uniform for each day that they attend school.
